The Players

- 32 young men have played for the AppleSox this season.
- 7 played here before...Kyle Blankenship, Zach Haggett, Joey Jensen, Reign Letkeman, Colton Loomis, Kyle Vanderkin and Hunter Wells...the highest number of returnees in 10 years.
- 433 have donned the red, white and blue all together in 16 years.
- There has been one 4-year player, 12 have been here three seasons and 42 spent two summers on the local diamond.

Miscellany

- Wenatchee is just a half game behind Walla Walla in the East Division standings.
- The sixth month of the year ended with an 11-12 record (47.8%)...the third lowest June winning percentage in 16 seasons (2007, 8-12, 40% and 2000, 10-12, 45.5%).
- The 12 losses tie with 2000 and 2007 for the most in June.
- Five of the last six games with Walla Walla have been decided by one run (Sox are 1-4).
- With the 5-4 win last night the Sox are now 4-5 in one-run games this season and 144-106 all-time.
